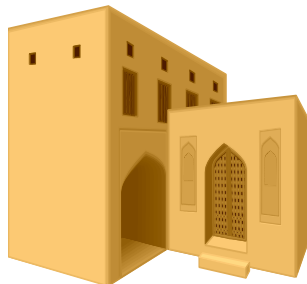

not the costs of living in Africa of living in a small-developed housing in an African city like Bamako (Mali) can range \$500.00 dollars a month. Rent range from \$2,500 to \$6,000 a year.

- **Donate toward School Operations costs Mali: Donations accepted at \$250 dollars a month or above for support of this program. Building a School is our best choice to insure schools operate long term and that fees associated with education remain minimal. In fact, a building plan with 10 small classrooms and 2 boarding units can start as low as \$5,000 (approximate cost of constructing 2-3, 12ft square rooms) and up to \$25,000 to complete 10 to 12 similar sized rooms. Purchase price of land varies and other structural costs fluctuate depending on the weather seasons (rainy or dry) and types of building materials used.**

In spite of the costs very soon an economical 'green' school structure will be constructed with low-cost bricks of clays and low-cost renewable energy sources for power (small wind and solar systems) to support a minimal electric output and hot water, including solar-ovens to cut down the use of coal, gas and electricity for cooking school meals. Two classrooms could start as early as October 2007.
