



Many of our students at EPIAD in 2006 attended school for the first time. Some were as old as 12 years old and had little formal education before EPIAD. Keeping fees minimal is a strategy to halt ILLITERACY and increase access to education among children. Parents were very excited seeing their children with book bags and school uniforms for the first time.

Heretofore, these parents feared their children would never have an opportunity to be schooled in a formal setting! Remember children always learn informally, as PARENTS ARE THEIR FIRST TEACHERS!

- ✓ Scholarship programs provide opportunities for children to attend school for the VERY FIRST TIME! These children would remain unable to read and write without YOUR gifts!
